## ACCEPTANCE of ROADS

<u>Purpose</u> The purpose of this amendment is to insure the uniform acceptance, or reclassification to a higher standard, of Roads, Highway Projects, Bridges, or other Appurtenances by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Sunderland.

Inspection Upon completion of a Road, or other Highway Project, Bridge, or Appurtenance, the Board of Selectmen, or other persons authorized by the Board of Selectmen shall inspect the site to insure conformance to previously agreed upon specifications. These findings shall be presented to the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting, whereupon the Board may action:

- A. Accept the Road, Highway Project, Bridge, or other Appurtenance, in an as is condition with no further obligation on the part of the contractor, developer, or applicant. Provided however the Road, Highway Project, Bridge, or other Appurtenance complies with the Town's Highway Specification, or previously agreed upon specifications.
- B. Require that, the Road, Highway Project, Bridge, or other Appurtenance shall be allowed to withstand the effects of one (1) winter/mud season/spring change of seasons, prior to final acceptance by the Board.
- C. Decide not to accept the responsibility for the continued maintenance of the Road, Highway Project, Bridge or Appurtenance, on behalf of the TOWN. The Board shall notify the contractor, developer, or applicant stating the reasons for such decision, and make recommendations for correction.

Notification The Board of Selectmen shall notify the contractor, developer, or applicant in writing within fifteen (15) days of any such
