

TOWN OF SUNDERLAND
Winter Parking Ordinance

WHEREAS pursuant to Title 23, V.S.A. §1008 the Town of Sunderland may regulate parking on public highways within the Town; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Title 24, V.S.A. §229(4) the Town is empowered to regulate the operation and use of the vehicles within the Town; and

WHEREAS the parking of vehicles within the public right-of-way when snow removal may be required has created a nuisance and a threat to the public health, safety, welfare and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town;

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Title 24, V.S.A. §1971 et seq. the Selectmen of the Town of Sunderland, Vermont adopt the following ordinance for the regulation of parking within the limits of the public highways within the Town of Sunderland:

1. Between November 1 of each calendar year and May 1 of the immediately following calendar year no person shall park or cause to be parked any motor vehicle within the limits of the public highways of the Town of Sunderland at any time snow removal operations may be in progress anywhere within the Town.

2. Motor or other vehicles parked, or caused to be parked, in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by a police officer or by an employee of the Town of Sunderland road crew to a place of storage, and the person owning or controlling said vehicle so removed shall be liable to the Town of Sunderland for all costs of removal and storage.

3. Any violation of this Ordinance is punishable by a fine of \$50.00 for each offense.

4. This Ordinance shall become effective sixty (60) days from the date of its adoption or March 17th, 1983.

Adopted by the Selectmen of the Town of Sunderland, Vermont in accordance with the provisions of Title 24, V.S.A. §1972 this 17th day of January, 1983.
