## Sunderland Safe Roads Committee - Minutes from 4/ 13/16

Committee met to discuss presenting less costly alternatives following town meeting to the select board. Members noted that several residents approached committee members asking if there were less costly alternatives to what was presented. Committee members agreed that the hill of Sunderland Hill Rd. from the public works building to the top of the hill, structure 26 from the study, presents the most safety concerns for pedestrians, bicyclist and motorist.

Committee members agreed to focus on the above mentioned area. Marie, committee chairperson, will contact Jim Sullivan from BCRC, to request figures on the above mentioned area for signage, painting white lines on Sunderland Hill Rd. and widening the shoulder of the uphill side between public works building and structure 26. This is a safety issue for all and committee felt it was imperative to focus on this. Committee also felt share the road signage, a total of at least 4 would increase awareness on all of Sunderland Hill Rd.

Committee members will gather necessary information and tentatively scheduled to present to the select board for approval to apply for a grant, either this year or next. If approval received for grant application, and grant awarded it will then go before town meeting for residents to approve.
