- 1. Call to order by Mark Hyde
- 2. Board members present
  - a. Rick Timmerman, Jon French, Mark Hyde, and Steven Bendix
  - b. Audience
    - i. Rose Keough (Town Secretary/Treasurer), Marc Johnston
      (Highway Foreman), Greg Sukiennik (Manchester Journal), Fred
      Blackmer (Sunderland Resident)
- 3. Session recorded by GNAT-TV
- 4. Approval of Minutes from May 1, 2017
  - a. Add Andrew McKeever (GNAT Staff Member), and Edwin Chernosky II
    (Sunderland Resident) to Audience from previous meeting
  - Motion made to approve the previous meeting minutes made by Bendix,
    seconded by French, motion passed
- 5. Report from Road Liaison and/or Highway Foreman
  - a. Flashing light installed at Town Garage, programmed to run from 6 am -10 pm
    - Johnston will check the other flashing light as it isn't turning off and on properly
  - b. Near the Battenkill the guardrails were moved back

- c. The red town truck has been cleaned
- d. There is still \$900 of gravel left to do shoulder work with
- e. The town equipment was brought up to Sunderland Elementary for the students and staff to interact with
  - i. Positive reactions from students, as well as thank yous
- f. Grant Work
  - i. North Road Bridge
    - Closed for a minimum of two weeks during bridge replacement
      - a. The plan will be to get this done before school starts
    - 2. \$96,975 of grant money was approved
  - ii. Sunderland Hill Road box culvert
    - 1. \$87,885 of grant money was approved
    - Closed for a minimum of two weeks during culvert replacement
    - Will schedule for either after the North Road Bridge replacement is finished or next summer when school is out depending on scheduling with the contractor
  - iii. Hill Farm Paving
    - 1. \$37,150.40 of grant money was approved
  - iv. PACIF Grant 50% match

- \$658 of grant money was approved for back up cameras for town equipment
- g. Paving
  - i. North Road
    - 1. \$65,000 from the Paving budget
- h. Discuss/approve new plow purchase
  - i. Similar plow as on new truck, put twelve foot instead of eleven
    - 1. Plows soft roads easier
    - 2. Order now to get in this fiscal year
- i. John Deere riding tractor \$2623 for the X350
  - i. There is indoor storage
  - ii. Hyde asked if it is worth purchasing this, or saving the time and contracting the job out
    - Timmerman and Johnston said that with the discount they will receive, it's worth the purchase
    - The purchase will come out of the Town Budget,Maintenance
  - iii. Motion made by Bendix to approve the grant and allow Hyde to sign it, for the amount of \$96,975 North Road Bridge Project, seconded by Timmerman, motion passed

iv. Motion made by Timmerman to approve the grant and allow Hyde to sign it, for for the amount of \$37,150.40 the Hill Farm Paving, seconded by French, motion passed

    - Motion made to appoint Scott Magrath to a 2 year position on the Planning Board by French, seconded by Timmerman, motion passed
    - Motion made to appoint Tucker Kimball to a 3 year position on the Planning Board by French, seconded by Bendix, motion passed
- 7. Review of Bills, Correspondence, and Signing of Select Board's Orders
  - a. Haskins propane Rose will figure out how much we used last year and get back to Hyde, Hyde will then get back to the Board

- b. Casella's is increasing the rate by 1.516% at the Sunderland and East
  Dorset Transfer Stations
