

Although it is the Town's policy to use special care and consideration when plowing in the vicinity of mailboxes, the Town will not repair or replace, mailboxes and newspaper boxes or mailbox posts damaged by snow or ice clearing operations. Heavy snow coming off the plow blade will often knock over and damage mailboxes/posts that have not been adequately mounted and maintained or braced, or those mailboxes with doors left open.

If the Road Foreman determines that the mailbox damage was a result of direct contact from a Town vehicle, and not the result of other factors, such as a decayed post or the accumulation of snow, the owner of the mailbox shall be entitled to a maximum reimbursement of **\$30.00**.

All new mail boxes installed under this policy shall be an approved US Post Office mail box and installed per the US Post Office mailbox guidelines.
