Jeff D will submit the request for the Mini-Grant - MERP (Municipal Energy Resilience Program – Act 172) to BCRC. Once the application is complete, it will be presented to the Selectboard for approval for submission to the State. The committee agreed to request the \$4,000. For this grant. Funds unused will be returned.

The Fall Climate Change Transition Forum will need to establish the date for the forum so potential panelists can confirm their participation. Andrew M will see if dates in October are available at Burr & Burton for the forum. Other possible locations may need to be determined if BBA is not available. Katharine & Andrew will continue to recruit panelists.

Jeff D. will send the information explaining what a "Green Procurement Town" is and states that there is no obligation to procure any items, only that the town will consider buying "Green" where possible.
