# 9. Act 71 Grant & Construction Updates

The CUD website has been updated with the construction schedule and a map showing wire center coverage in the CUD territory. CCI often does pre-construction work so there may be activity in towns where construction hasn't officially started yet. Once construction starts, it takes approximately 3-5 months until service is expected to be available. CCI is currently on schedule with all construction.

One of the challenges CCI experienced during Phase 1 was installation at multi-unit dwellings which often required coordinating with a landlord. If any CUD representatives know of any multi-unit dwellings or condo associations in their town where people are interested in getting Fidium, please let the CUD officers know and they can flag those locations with CCI.

The CUD is in compliance with all reporting requirements and there have been several meetings between the CUD, CCI, and VCBB to discuss the field inspection process. A celebration of Phase 2 is tentatively planned for early August.

#### 10. Other Business

Andrew McKeever received some questions about at a recent select board meeting about how people in rural areas of the town can get Fidium. If they are connected to the electrical grid and have telephone wires running by their house, they are likely to be eligible for service. The best way to request service is to go to the Fidium website and pre-order. The address input system can sometimes be tricky, so anyone with questions about their eligibility can reach out to any of the CUD officers, or Jonathan or Callie to get confirmation.

The VCBB is developing a 5-year digital equity plan to qualify for funding from the Broadband Access and Deployment Program (BEAD) and they are seeking public input via listening sessions and a Request for Input form.
